Errata statement

The editors of *Animal Law in Australasia* and Tony Bogdanoski, the author of Chapter 4, acknowledge the following errors on p 98 and p 99 of the book:

1. Factual errors in footnote 83
 - a. The citation for the J McGowan article is incorrect. It should be the Law Society Journal, September 2012.
 - b. Lawyers for Companion Animals is not a community legal centre. At no time was it stated on the Lawyers for Companion Animals website that the organisation was a community legal centre.
2. Misrepresentation
 - a. Any implication that Anne Greenaway believes that most lawyers in animal law “overlook the (arguably cruel) euthanasia of hundreds of thousands of relinquished ‘healthy’ cats and dogs in Australasia” is false and without foundation.
 - b. The statement “However, those advocating a ‘no kill’ approach in SPCAs and other animal shelters also need to propose how this can be achieved ...” suggests that Anne Greenaway and others in the No Kill movement have not provided suggestions with regard to how this can be achieved. The opposite is the case. There is a great deal of published material, publically available, which indicates how a “no kill” approach can and has been achieved.
 - c. The statement “Greenaway also suggests that Australasian animal lawyers are consciously blind to, or uninterested in, the destruction of companion animals in ‘rescue’ shelters” is false and without foundation.
3. Incorrect geographical focus

The references to “Australasia” on p 98 and p 99 are inaccurate and should read “Australia”.
